- Raise your hand if you would like to speak. On Zoom
  - Go to your Zoom menu bar and click on the More option (...). Raise Hand should be a choice. Note: this option may vary by device and operating system used.
  - OR raise your hand on your Zoom screen so we can see it
- Each member may speak only once until all others have had an opportunity to speak
- Be brief and focused in your remarks
- Listen carefully to what other say without making assumptions
- Wait to be recognized by the current acting chairperson
- Avoid walking around with your phone/tablet while connected to Zoom. If you need to be sure to disable your camera first
- Zoom formalities:
  - All Participants will be muted when they come into the meeting.
  - You may unmute when it is your turn to talk. When finished, be sure to mute yourself.
  - The Host will manage who is speaking, and who is speaking next.

## Red River UU Behavioral Covenant

Adopted by the Congregation on November 8, 2009 Reaffirmed October 20, 2013 Reaffirmed October 30, 2016 Reaffirmed October 21, 2018 Reaffirmed October 20, 2019

We, the members of Red River Unitarian Universalist Church, affirm that *in our interactions with each other:* 

\* We will communicate with *respect* and genuine positive regard

- o By recognizing positive characteristics in others
- o By giving and receiving both information and opinion with respect
- o By separating our feelings about people from our opinions of their behavior
- o By considering others' perspectives
- o By respecting each other's privacy and need for confidentiality

\* We will communicate with care to preserve our sense of community and belonging

- o By supporting the congregation, its mission, and vision
- o By looking for common ground
- o By participating actively while reserving the right to pass
- o By expecting and accepting unfinished business

\* We will communicate with **autonomy** to preserve our personal and collective **integrity** 

- o By speaking from our own experiences
- o By practicing forgiveness and finding our own absolution
- o By recognizing when to let go
- o By maintaining clear boundaries and monitoring our own status within this covenant

Further, we resolve that in our interactions with one another there is no room for assumptions, judgments, accusations, side conversations, or triangulated communication.

## Annual Report of Committees

#### Board of Trustees Report: July 1, 2020 through May 1, 2021

This has been a very unusual year. Due to the pandemic, the building has been closed since March 2020 so this entire budget year the Board has had to conduct its business via Zoom meetings and emails. With the building closed, the church has had to focus its efforts into becoming a virtual church with YouTube and Facebook Sunday services and having various scheduled events and Team meetings also held using Zoom. The Board has had to spend a certain amount of effort in support of these changes.

The Board (working with the Finance Team) identified cost savings measures in the budget to help offset the reduced revenue from Sunday collections. These cost saving measures has helped us keep within budget for this year.

The Board did 3 rounds of calling members to check on everyone during the shutdown. Member issues were turned over to the Membership Team for follow-up.

Approved the Finance Team recommendation to move a portion of our savings and all our endowment funds from Independent Bank to UUA UUCEF Funds.

Held Spring and Fall congregational meetings using Zoom. Held monthly Board meetings using Zoom.

The Board accepted Jan Fletcher's resignation as Treasurer and approved Marilyn Alexander as the Treasurer.

In place of the spring awards dinner, the Board held "Church Re-Imagined: behind the curtain" Zoom meeting. The Board is reviewing this list of ideas for future implementation.

Approved the Shelter use of the building for Thanksgiving food handout and Christmas food and present handout. In April they used one of the garage bays to store items for their end-of-April yard sale.

Researched the cost of getting a billboard. Price ranges from \$300-\$1,200 per month plus a setup fee for a one-year commitment. The Board decided to not consider a billboard at this time.

Worship speaker costs went from \$250 to \$315 per service starting Jan 2021. Board approved additional funds to cover the increase in speaker costs. \$3,835 was approved to allow the Worship Team to continue with 3 outside speakers per month and cover the increase in the speaker fee.

Reviewed and approved the schedule for the pledge drive and May Congregational Meeting.

In anticipation of the church opening hopefully sometime this summer or fall, the Board has prepared two documents. The **Safe Church Opening Protocols** document identifies how we conduct social gatherings in the building and procedures to follow for safe cleaning of the building. This document follows CDC guidelines that have been adapted for our church. The **Red River UU Church Reopening Todo List** document identifies all the tasks we need to do in order to open the building. It also identifies additional costs in order to prepare the building and maintain the health guidelines necessary once we open. The Board is currently working on various items on this list.

The Board created a procedure for logging and tracking special funds that are donated to the church. These special funds usually have some restrictions on how they may be spent. These donations are tracked outside the normal budget process, so that doing budget variance reporting analysis is more accurate.

The Board gives a big THANK YOU to everyone that helped make our virtual church a success this year. A special shout out goes to the Worship Team for their great on-line services and the Board also recognizes the great production work done by Marla and Doug in preparing these on-line services.

#### **Nominating Committee**

The Nominating Committee is made up of Amy Hoffman-Shehan, Kelly Dyer and Donald Rogers. Donald was appointed by the Board of Trustees to fill LD Clark's term that was left vacant after his death.

Positions that need to be filled are: Vice President, At Large Board Position, Nominating Committee, and Committee on Ministry. Marilyn Alexander is the nominee for Vice President. She currently serves as Treasurer. The Board of Trustees will appoint Dick Powell as Treasurer to fill the seat that Marilyn will vacate. Amy Hoffman-Shehan is the nominee for the At Large Board position. Dan Althoff is eligible for a second term on Committee on Ministry and has agreed to run for re-election. Amy Hoffman-Shehan's term on the Nominating Committee ends this year. She is not eligible to run for re-election since she has agreed to be on the ballot for the Board of Trustees. Kelly and Donald will need to find a 3<sup>rd</sup> member for the Nominating Committee.

#### **Committee on Ministry**

Definition of the Committee on Ministry (COM) as found in the Policies and Procedures Manual:

"The purpose of the Committee on Ministry is to strengthen and support the congregational health of Red River UU Church by promoting effective ministries in all areas of Red River's mission. Working to uphold the philosophy of shared ministry, the Committee on Ministry seeks to affirm healthy relations between congregation members, between congregation and board as well as between the minister and the congregation."

The COM usually meets once a month on the fourth Sunday. During these meetings we address various areas of Church Life to determine if the congregations' needs are being met. Additionally, during these meetings the COM is also available to individual members who have problems in the congregation. Please contact any one of us if you want to talk or have an issue.

This year the COM did a survey on, and reviewed how church was taking place during Covid-19 via zoom and internet. There haven't been any other issues addressed in the past year. Committee on Ministry

#### **Membership Committee**

The lack of in-person worship services the past few months has meant that people haven't been applying for membership in the church. However, people have joined the church's worship services by YouTube or Facebook, and we now have 83 subscribers to our YouTube channel. Numerous people have filled out on-line visitor cards, and one or more of the Membership Team contacts these folks to welcome their interest and learn more details about them. We've had a few visitors join us (some from out of our geographical region, even from other states!) in both Adult Forum and in the Coffee-and-Conversation time that follows worship service. Not all visitors return on subsequent Sundays, but some do and show a real interest in being part of the church.

The Membership Team will be having a meeting soon to discuss ways to adapt our procedures for greeters, etc., once the in-person services resume. We will also be considering ways to adjust the path to membership for those who live at a distance, for instance to let someone else sign the membership book for them at their request.

Although the pandemic has meant that some of our former practices haven't worked while we're physically apart, the technological adaptations it necessitated have also helped us broaden our outreach to communities at a physical distance from us. Red River UU has adapted to many different situations over our brief 20+-year history, and we will do this too. Necessary change can mean opportunity, and it seems to be working that way for our small church.
